



Dear Student,

I hope you are looking forward to Joining the UTC in September as we all crave the need for normality. Although the last few months have been very disruptive; your future is bright, the opportunities available to you by joining the UTC and DC6 partnership are phenomenal including bridging the link between education and the world of employment.

I am writing to provide clarity for the enrolment process over the coming weeks; your enrolment into Doncaster UTC; start dates in September; the possibility of taster days; getting to Doncaster UTC; and information about the Doncaster UTC dress code.

Subject to government guidelines, enrolment into Doncaster UTC post 16 will occur on GCSE results day once you have picked up your grades from your current school. This year our partnership with the Hall Cross means you will be able to enrol at Hungerhill School in Edenthorpe or Hall Cross Academy. Students who currently attend Hall Cross are still welcome to enrol at Hungerhill School.

Students wishing to join Doncaster UTC Post 16 provision that are currently studying at Hungerhill or Hall Cross can enrol from 9am onward, students studying elsewhere at are welcome to arrive and enrol from 11:30am onward at Hungerhill or Hall Cross Academy. I can confirm that there will be no advantage to arriving early so take your time to enjoy picking your GCSE results up.

If you are unable to attend either location on GCSE results day, please email our data manager, Rosie Everley: <u>Everley.R@hungerhillschool.com</u> to arrange a convenient time to come and enrol between results day and the start of term.

I will update you on how the process will change should government advice determine that we cannot host a face to face enrolment day in August.

Online Enrolment

All online Enrolment has now commenced and we are actively encouraging you complete this as soon as possible if we are your preferred choice. Providing you meet the entry criteria on exam results day *this will guarantee your place*, as we will be oversubscribed.

Enrolment on GCSE results day - 20th August

It looks unlikely that we will be able to offer taster days in the summer term as had been our intention. If government advice changes and we are able to put taster days on we will do so. **Getting to Doncaster UTC**

Doncaster UTCs central location means we are very easy to get to. Most students use public transport in their first year, and we provide information on how to get a travel pass on GCSE results day.

Induction day(s) Friday 11th September 2020

Doncaster UTCs induction day is on Friday 11th September. You will arrive on site for 9am. The induction day itself will involve an assembly, some time with your academic tutor and if the weather is good, we'll have a BBQ in the post 16 quad.

The majority of students who have applied have indicated that they want to study courses which are entirely located at Doncaster UTC. However, excitingly, a significant number of you have applied indicating that you want to study courses spanning both post 16 provisions.

Students who have applied to the DC6th partnership and have chosen to do courses across the UTC and Hall Cross sites will need to attend the Hall Cross induction date on Tuesday 1st September 2020, even if the bulk of your timetable will be at the UTC. You will become fully aware of your timetable balance on GCSE results day.

Changing Subjects Choices

If you have decided you would like to change the courses you said you wanted to study at the interview, you can let us know on GCSE results day. You do not have to do anything now.
